WHAT IS "DESIGN-BUILD"?

Although design-build is not necessarily a format RPAP traditionally embraces, we were approached a few years ago to pursue the new Hay River Health Centre in a design-build format. While having done a few design-build projects prior to this we had never completed one of this size or complexity. The project is over halfway through construction and we can report that it has been a rewarding experience. Design-build relies on a single contract between the design-build team and the owner. It is intended to minimize risks for the owner and to reduce the delivery schedule by overlapping the design phase and construction phase of a project. The design-build RFP document is very important as it sets all the specific parameters of the project before the



design-build team is engaged. Once awarded, the design team works to meet the requirements of the RFP and deliver the project in a very quick timeframe. While delivering the project in a faster timeframe and for a fixed cost, the process does at times present some challenges, namely the limited ability for the users to provide greater input on the design. However, we were able to successfully manage and balance expectations, and now we look forward to seeing the project completed and the community benefiting from the services it will offer. ●

BUILDING INFORMATION MODELING (BIM)
